Collusion exists

Dinah Shumway sees crony collusion in Mark Reynolds' assertion that some Congressional Republicans acknowledge climate change and fossil fuels cause warming. Shumway is right, collusion exists, but wrong about who's colluding. All the pseudo-scientific information she presents is refuted on SkepticalScience. com. Readers should ask Congressman Paul Cook to sponsor carbon fee and dividend legislation, a clear sign of wellinformed patriotism.
