2:12 שמו This note is a list of unique words all beginning with the letter ש. — Details: Almost every item in this list also appears in an OwO list (see especially OwO P §§ 5, 6, 8, 12, 56 and 57). Also see Mm notes in P (198b) and B (109b) listing unique words beginning with ש, but those lists include words with prefixed ש, while this list has no words with prefixed ש.

Concerning the form שקד, it could represent either שקד (Jer 1:11) or שָקד (Ps 127:1), but see OwO §8 which lists שָקד (Jer 1:11) along with other items from this list in almost the same order.

The form שלחו could be שלחו (Gen 44:3), שלחו (1 Sam 5:11), שלחו (2 Kgs 2:17), or שלחו (Ps 74:7), but see the Mm at Ezek 5:16 and OwO 2H §20M which lists 1 Sam 5:11 with שלחיני (1 Sam 19:17).

The form שלחוני appears twice (Gen 24:54, 56), but perhaps שלחיני (1 Sam 19:17) was intended.

The form שיתו could be שיתו (Isa 10:17) or שיתו (Ps 48:14). Since שיתו (Isa 10:17) is in OwO §33, but not

שיתו (Ps 48:14), I assume Isa 10:17 was intended here.

Although שכלתי (Gen 43:14) is written with a Babylonian vowel sign for *hōlem* to identify this form, the next item שכלתי appears in this note without a vowel sign, and could be שָכלתי (Gen 43:14) or שכלתי (Jer 15:7). However, see OwO §5 in which the two forms from Gen 43:14 are paired.

The form שאַר is not unique. Perhaps the intended unique word was שאַר (1 Sam 16:11).

The form שרשי could be either שרשי (Job 13:27) or שרשי (Job 29:19).

The form שפל could be either שָפל (Isa 2:11) or שפל (Prov 16:19)•

4:18 מָר This note is a list of unique words and it ends with a statement saying “these are (accented with) *zāqēp* (and vocalized with) *qāmeš*.” — Details: For similar lists, see a longer alphabetical list in N at Isa 49:1 (folio 22a), or OwO P §21•

6:8 [י] הַנְּסָרָ[י] This note is a list of unique words ending with רִי. — Details: the last item in the list cannot be read because the manuscript is torn. For similar rhyming lists, see Dotan, *Awakening*, 51•

7:18 [מִלְקָטִים] This note is a list of unique words ending with טִים. — Details: the first item in the list is missing because the manuscript is torn but the expected anchor would be מִלְקָטִים (Jer 7:18) which appears in the text of N on this page with a Mp note saying it is unique. However, the form מִלְקָטִים is also in the text of L at Judg 1:7. When מִלְקָטִים appears again at the end of this list it might be a duplicate mention of Jer 7:18 or it might refer to Judg 1:7. Perhaps there was a tradition of vocalizing these two items (Jer 7:18 and Judg 1:7) differently (perhaps Judg 1:7 was treated by some as a passive? cf. Isa 27:12). Cf. Ginsburg מ § 27•

7:27 וּלֹא יַעֲנוּכָה This note is a list of unique two-word phrases in which the first word is וּלֹא. — Details: except for the anchor, the items in this list are all in Torah, are presented in the order of the biblical books and all appear again in the Bible without a prefixed ו.

Concerning וּלֹא תֹאסְפוֹן (Exod 9:28), it appears in the text of L as וּלֹא תִסְפוֹן but see the Mm note in Breuer, 247, which treats Exod 9:28 as a form of תֹאסְפוֹן.

The form וּלֹא תִקְ[ח] (Deut 16:19) is reconstructed based on: there being room for only one more letter, the ordering of the list, and the appearance of this phrase in similar lists in Lm (see Breuer, 539 and 687-8)•

8:14 הדמנו This note is a partial alphabetical list (י to ד) of unique words grouped in sets of three, and each set of three derives from the same root, and the first word of the set is from Torah, the second is from Prophets, and the third is from Writings. — Details: most words in this list are in OwO P §56, but this list's three ד-words differ from those of OwO, and do not fit the pattern of אנך. This list skips ה, though OwO does present ה-words.

As ו-words, this list and OwO present three words from שוב all beginning with ן.

The word ט[חון] (Deut 9:21) is smudged and reconstructed based on OwO. Concerning טָחֹן (Judg 16:21), the ן seems dotted (ו) to indicate a correction to the misspelling, but see OwO H §57 for the same misspelling.

The י-words יושור, יוסר, יושר are from three separate roots (שור, שיר, שור). Cf. OwO P §56, H §57•

9:14 מאכילם This note is a partial alphabetical list (ע to א) of unique words all ending in ם-ָ. — Details: Concerning בודם (Neh 6:8), it is spelled בודאם in L, but בודם is found in the Mm notes of Lm (Breuer, 206) and P (Mm note at Isa 33:7). This list does not include a ט-word, although ט-words appear in a version of this list in N (see in N folio 96b-97a) and in OwO P §34. שפתם serves as a ס-word, although a ס-word appears in some versions of this list (see Breuer, 634). For similar lists, see Dotan, *Awakening*, 52; Breuer, 206, 634; Weil §1310•

10:4 ייפהו This note is a list of unique words that all end with והו-י. — Details: The form ויניחוהו (Isa 46:7) is in the text of N as ויניחהו. For similar lists, see Dotan, *Awakening*, 50; and the Mm of N at Isa 45:13•

10:4 יחזקום This note is a list of unique words that all end with קום-•

11:12 בעת רעתם This note is a list of two unique phrases which differ by only one letter•

11:19 ונכרתנו This note is a list of unique words that all end with נו. — Details: The form סביבתינו occurs four times in the text of L (but see Mandl 790 which indicates Dan 9:16 is the only one written without the second י). The form קולינו occurs twice in the text of L as קלנו (Num 20:16; Deut 26:7), and twice with prefixed ב (Deut 21:20; 2 Sam 12:18). But see Breuer 615 and Ginsburg § 107 for a note identifying 2 Sam 12:18 as the only one plene ו. If 2 Sam 12:18 was intended, the

form in the note should have been בקולנו.

The form ענו could be the unique ענו (1 Sam 12:3) or the unique ענו (Isa 27:2). יצפֹּנו (Ps 56:7) is written with a Babylonian sign for *hōlem*. For a similar list, see the Mm of N at Jer 20:10•

15:6 וְאֵט This note presents an alphabetical list of unique words that all (except the anchor) are two-letter words. — Details: This list does not contain words beginning with ט, נ, ב, ו; most of the items in this list are vocalized with *qāmeṣ*, but the following are vocalized in the text of L with *pataḥ*: אֵט, גֵּשׁ, גֵּע, יָד, פָּס. The form גש could either represent גָּשׁ (Gen 19:9) or גֵּשׁ (2 Sam 1:15); the form תָּר does not exist in the text of L, and perhaps תָּו (Ezek 9:4) was intended. Cf. OwO P §21 and §40• 257

15:12 היָרַע This note lists unique words from the root רעע and has a summary saying היָרַע “has none like it (and it) starts a verse and one יָרַע, Job 34:24, is defective.” — Details: Both words are written in this note with a Babylonian sign for *hōlem*. In the text of L, both are defective and both start a verse•

16:3 הילודים This note lists unique words from the root ילד and it ends with a summary statement saying “these have none like them of the root ילידה ‘procreation’.” — Details: The anchor appears three times in L, but only here is it written plene.

The form הילדות could be the unique הילדות (Jer 16:3) or the unique הילדות (Eccl 11:10).

At Jer 16:3 in the text of N, המולדים is written המולדם. The form הולדת is either the unique הולדת (Gen 48:6) or הולדת which occurs three times but only once plene (Ezek 16:4).

The word ומולדות is in L twice, once doubly plene ומולדות (Ezek 16:4), and once doubly defective ומולדות (Ezek 16:3), but the form ומולדות is in a Mm note in C with a reference to Ezek 16:4 (Lyons, *Cumulative Masora*, 60).

The word הולידו is in the text of L twice, once written

הולידו (Lev 25:45) and once written הולידו (Ezek 47:22). See Breuer’s discussion of notes for this root (583-84)•

16:6 יקרַח This note lists one unique word and ends with a statement saying “and similarly all the world (everything else).” — Details: It is unclear how to understand this statement. In Tiberian tradition יקרַח is the only *nip’al* imperfect (with a final guttural) in a non-pausal position that has a *šerê* with the middle root letter. Perhaps the note explains that the *šerê* was retained in order to link it with forms from the same root, and to avoid confusion with other roots having a *pataḥ*•

16:21 מודיעם This note lists unique words ending with עָם. — Details: The form זרועם (Isa 33:2) is in the text of N as זרועם.

The form יבלעם is in the text of L twice (Judg 1:27; 2 Kgs 9:27), but ובלעם (Num 23:2) is unique, and perhaps the initial י was a confusion due to the next name.

The form יקמעם is either יקמעם (1 Chr 6:53) or יקמעם (1 Chr 24:23). See a similar note in N at Isa 33:2•

17:6 כערער This note lists a unique word and ends with a statement saying “and its parallel הערער is unique”•

17:14 וְאוֹשְׁעָה This note lists unique words ending with עָה. — Details: In the text of L, וְאוֹשְׁעָה occurs twice (Jer 17:14; Ps 119:117). However, in N at Jer 17:14 a Mp note says וְאוֹשְׁעָה is unique.

וְאוֹשְׁעָה (Ps 119:117) is vocalized in the note וְאוֹשְׁעָה, but it is וְאוֹשְׁעָה in the text of A, L and V. However, see Yeivin, *Hebrew Language*, 697 for examples of this word vocalized with *səgōl* in Babylonian manuscripts. וְאוֹשְׁעָה (Isa 24:19) is וְאוֹשְׁעָה in the text of N•

18:6 הַכִּיּוֹצֵר This note lists unique words ending with צָר and the note ends with a summary statement saying “these have none like them.” — Details: The item וְלֶחֶצֶר (1 Kgs 7:12) ends with צָר, it does not fit this list, and it is vocalized differently in the text of L as וְלֶחֶצֶר•

18:14 הִיעֲזֹב This note lists unique words all beginning with prefixed הִ (interrogative)•

18:22 תִּשְׁמַע This note lists pairs of unique words with initial ת, one without, and one with, a prefixed ו. — Details: Concerning תּוֹרוֹת (Isa 24:5), it is in the text of N as תּוֹרָה. See a longer version of this list in the Mm of N at Ezek 44:8•

19:14 מֵהַתַּפַּת This note lists unique words all ending with פַּת. — Details: The last two words of this list end in פַּת so they do not match the other list items; also, they were written without לֹז between them. For similar lists, see Dotan, *Awakening*, 53; and the Mm note in C at 2 Kgs 16:17•

20:10 וּנְגִידָנִי This note lists unique words ending with נוּ, and the note ends with a summary statement saying “these are unique.” — Details: The note uses a Babylonian masoretic term דְּקָרִן which means “unique.” The form יַחֲנֹנִי could represent יְחַנְּנִי (Ps 67:2), or יְחַנְּנִי (Isa 27:11), or יְחַנְּנִי (Ps 102:15). The form יִסְלַקֹּנִי might represent Exod 8:22 (יִסְקִלוֹנִי), but two consonants have been inverted. In addition, there is a dot in the letter ס, suggesting it should be deleted. It is hard to know what word was intended.

20:17 הִרְתִּי This note lists unique words ending with רֶת. — Details: All list items are feminine singular construct forms. For similar lists, see Ginsburg 2, ת § 17, and the Mm of N at Jer 48:36•

21:14 בִיעֵרָהּ This note lists unique words ending with רָה, and the note ends with a summary statement saying “these have none like them.” — Details: There is a sign resembling a small ג or ^ over the final ה of each word; the sign seems to indicate a diacritical mark for the ה (i.e., *mappîq*). In Babylonian manuscripts, a ג or a ^ over a letter represents *dāgēš*, but a ה represents *mappîq* (see Dotan, “Masorah,” 16:1445). For a similar list, see Ginsburg 1, ה § 64b; for other lists of words ending with הֶ-, see Dotan, *Awakening*, 51 and the Mm of N at Isa 27:3; 28:4; and Jer 27:11•

The form הַקְּרָבִים appears twice (Ezek 40:46; 45:4), and in N both times it is accompanied by a Mp note indicating three occurrences; the third is without

prefixed ה (Deut 20:3). Perhaps this third occurrence was intended for this note. For similar lists, see the Mm of N at Ezek 2:6•

28:8 וַיִּנְבְּאוּ This note lists unique words beginning with וַי and ending with ו. — Details: With the exception of the last item in the list, all fit the pattern וַיִּקְטְלוּ (*nip'al*, third person plural imperfect with prefixed וַי). The list seems to have an alphabetical order that was disturbed. Concerning וַיִּנְתְּנוּ and וַיִּנְזְרוּ, they could be וַיִּנְתְּנוּ and וַיִּנְזְרוּ (1 Chr 5:20 and Hos 9:10), and match the other words in this list. Or they could be וַיִּנְתְּנוּ and וַיִּנְזְרוּ (2 Chr 18:4 and Lev 22:2). Since the other items in this list begin with וַי, I assumed these two do too. Concerning וַיִּפְּאוּ, this form does not appear in the text of L.

The form וַיִּמְרְרוּ is the only list item that is not a *nip'al*•

The form הַלְקַח is not unique: it appears twice in the text of L (1 Sam 4:19; 4:21). For similar lists, see Dotan, *Awakening*, 53; and Weil §4202•

30:8 ומוסרותיך This note lists unique words beginning with וּמ. — Details: In the text of N, the third וּ of ומוסרותיך (Jer 30:8) has been erased and a Mp note attached to the word reads: ל ומל לבבלא למערך חס (“unique and plene according to Babylonian tradition, to Western tradition defective”). The word ומולדתיך is in L twice, once doubly plene ומולדותיך (Ezek 16:4), and once doubly defective ומלדותיך (Ezek 16:3), but the form ומולדתיך is in a Mm note in C with a reference to Ezek 16:4 (Lyons, *Cumulative Masora*, 60).

The word סוכתים (1 Chr 2:55) is written שוכתים in the text of L.

The form הביאותים does not appear in the Bible. However, והביאותים occurs four times with various orthography; it is hard to know what word was intended. For a similar list, see the Mm note in N at Jer 25:9 listing words ending with תִּים •

31:20 [הב]ן This note lists unique words beginning with הב and the ב is written *rāpê* (i.e. the prefixed ה is not a definite article so there is no *dageš*). — Details: Two items הביאונם and הבנים (Num 32:17; Jer 49:1) are written in this list with prefixed ה although they should be written with a prefixed הָ. For a similar list, see OwO P§65 •

31:38 ונבנתה העיר This note lists pairs of two-word phrases, one with, and one without, a prefixed ה on the

second word of the phrase. — Details: All the phrases in this list appear in OwO §3, except the last. Concerning בעיר קדש, this phrase does not appear in the text of L (does appear at Neh 11:18). However, OwO §3 contains the phrases בהר ה/קדש (Ezek 28:14; Isa 27:13), and perhaps the repetition of the word עיר in this Mm note led to its use in this last phrase instead of בהר •

[] This note is unusual in that it has no clear anchor to this folio and it begins with a heading saying: “these have none like them: one (has) ן and one (has) ם at the end of the word.” — Details: All the items in this list are in OwO §12. In this list, after the word מִשׁוֹבָהּ, a note adds לֹא בֵט “there is none like it with this accent.” The word מִשׁוֹבָהּ appears five times in the Bible (in N and L it is always written מִשְׁבָּהּ): four times it is with *mûnah*, and once (Jer 3:12) it is accented with *mêhûppāk*.
